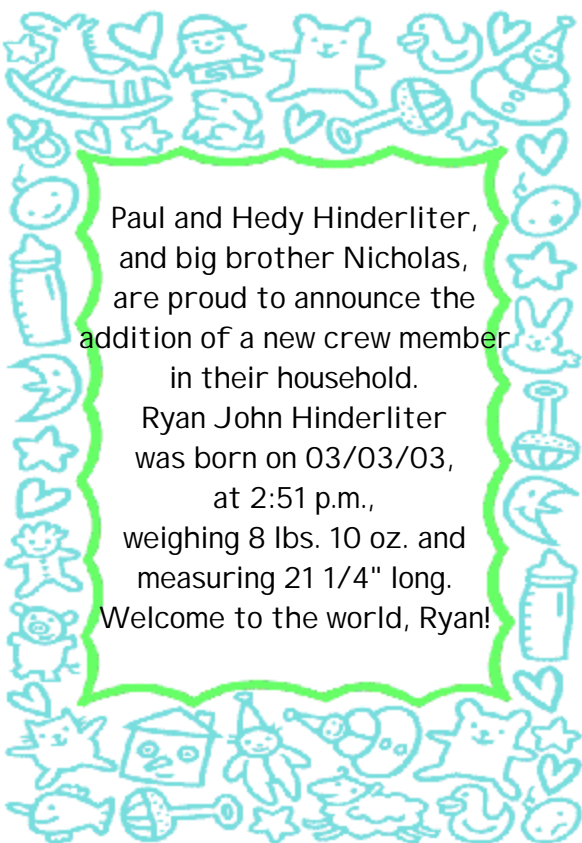
Dear PYC members,

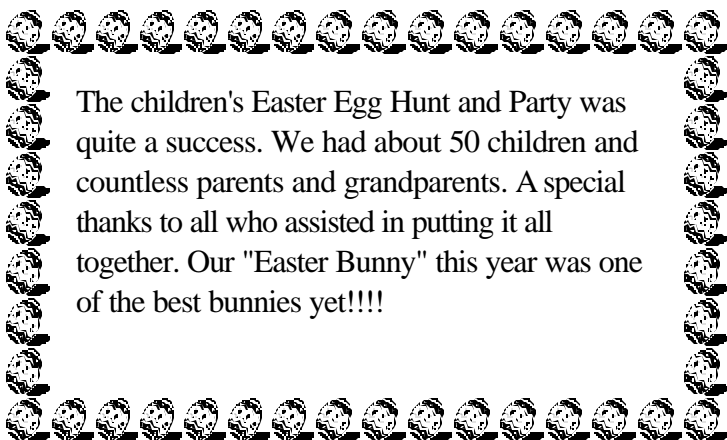
